### **INTRODUCTION**

As an initial step to the Adult Day Services Project, an extensive literature review was conducted to identify background research and data on the field. The University of Southern California School of Gerontology assisted in this search. Relevant journal articles, reports, books, fact sheets and newsletters were identified through Internet and library searches. In addition, contacts were made with leading researchers in the field to discuss the project and to obtain reprints of journal publications. Two key contacts included Nancy Cox, Partners in Caregiving Project, Wake Forest, and Steve Zarit, Penn State University.

A bibliography of the key documents that resulted from this search follows. They largely focus on the operational and service delivery characteristics of ADS programs.

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
